Extras	A natural oil starter pack can be supplied which includes 1 plastic container + 2 packs of oil impregnated pads. Kit part no SGEBSP.	

Operation / Fault finding

Unpacking:	Remove the keys from the back of the machine and open the front door. Remove the pack containing the mains lead, handle, and screw pack. Replace the front.
Fitting	The Bactokill can be free standing or wall mounted. If you wish to free stand it, the handle can be fitted to the top using the screws supplied. For wall mounting, use the screws supplied or other suitable fixing.
Servicing	The Bactokill lamps should be replaced every 6 to 12 months depending on the location and use. The filter should be inspected at least every 3 months and washed using a soap solution (i.e. washing up liquid) Replacement filters are available, part no. SFIL12. The lamps should also be wiped using a soft cotton cloth to remove any dust. DO NOT touch the lamps with your fingers.
Fault finding	A blue glow can be seen through the top air output grill. This indicates the lamps are working. If a glow cannot be seen then both lamps should be replaced. If the red neon by the mains input lead is not lit, this indicates there is a fuse blown in the plug or the mains socket on the wall is dead.

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
